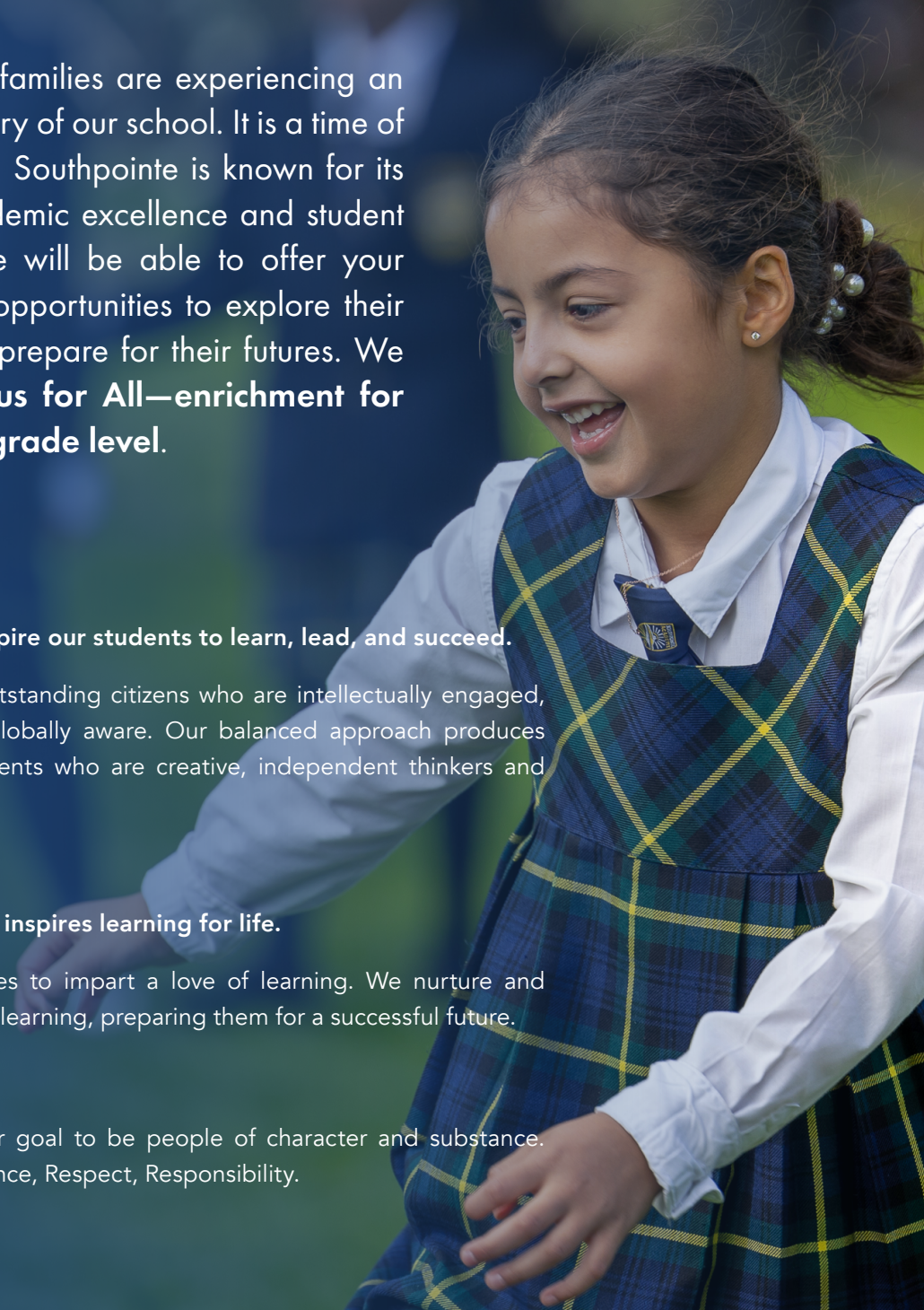

Southpointe Academy has been a centre of learning and success for close to 25 years. Our graduates are proudly accepted into their university of choice, where they excel in their chosen fields. The school community is strong, and your children are at the centre of every decision.

The 2020-2025 strategic plan goals are being achieved with great success, enrolment is at an all time high, and our finances are well managed. We are delivering on our mission and our promise.

Today, we are poised to capitalize on our momentum by addressing one of our strategic plan's most ambitious priorities: the development of Southpointe's facilities to **ensure success for every child in every grade** for today, tomorrow and the future.

Our expanded campus will unite the Junior, Middle and Senior Schools, and provide significant additional specialty classrooms, additional gymnasiums, theatre, art, technology and science classrooms.

The current estimate of the cost of this new facility is \$43 million, and Southpointe is embarking on a major fundraising campaign as one of the critical components of funding this project.



Involve, Instruct & Inspire

Southpointe is characterized by passionate teaching, open-mindedness and a warm, welcoming community. As an *International Baccalaureate World School*, Southpointe offers the IB Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP) and we are proud to share that in 2023, was approved to offer the Diploma Programme (DP). The first DP cohort began in September 2023. Southpointe is unique in its region, offering a full IB Continuum education from Kindergarten through to Grade 12 graduation.

Since our founding, the school has been characterized by consistently strong and steady growth. We have grown physically, in terms of facilities and resources, numerically in the size of our student body and academically in terms of our curricular and co-curricular offerings. In 2000, we opened with less than 100 students ranging from Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 8 in temporary premises. Today, there are 665 students and over 100 faculty and staff in approximately 80,000 square feet of space we own, and we are increasingly recognized for our academic and co-curricular excellence.

A Campus For All

Southpointe has developed an exciting new campus master plan designed to support the school's future thinking vision and growth. The major feature of the master plan is to develop a new, leading edge facility with approximately 74,000 square feet of academic space situated on the School's existing property. This expansion campus will enable Southpointe to fully realize its vision as a three-classes-per-grade, IB Continuum School from K-12 offering world leading programmes.

The expansion campus will be a state-of-the-art, flexible, purpose-built space designed to support learning for generations to come. It will benefit every student in every grade in the school through a number of enhancements, including:

SPECIALIST CLASSROOMS

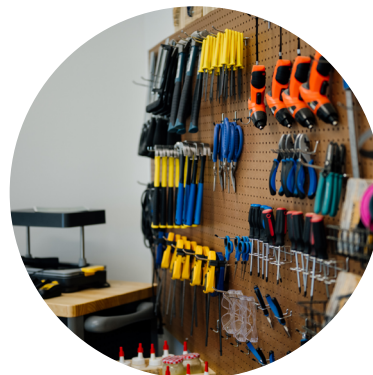
An incomparable number of specialty classrooms for each programme—PYP, MYP and DP—to enrich student learning for the mid-21st century and beyond.

DOUBLE GYMNASIUM

A dedicated hub for physical education, intramurals and daily recreational activities, our new double gymnasium promises to elevate Southpointe Academy's athletic programs. It will also provide another venue for assemblies and community events, with potential as a rental space as well. This new space will provide ample opportunities for Titan athletes to hone their skills, practice more frequently and push the boundaries of athletic excellence.

IN THE JUNIOR SCHOOL

Additional specialist classrooms for STEM, Performing Arts, Visual Arts and French; an enlarged Student Support Centre; and innovative collaboration hubs to support research and inquiry.



IN THE MIDDLE SCHOOL

Additional classrooms, a new project-based learning studio, enlarged collaboration spaces, dedicated science labs for MYP learners and studio spaces for visual arts, theatre arts and design.

IN THE SENIOR SCHOOL

New purpose-built learning studios, science labs, a university counselling centre and multimedia and visual art studios, all designed for the IB DP. A spectacular learning commons on the 6th Floor of the new addition, featuring breathtaking views across Boundary Bay and the North Shore mountains, providing a world class communal hub for our Senior students to truly experience a pre-university setting.

Overall, the expansion campus project will result in 28 additional classroom spaces to expand enrolment up to 850 students. The new facilities enable additional enrichment programs, athletic opportunities and clubs, offering an even more enriched experience for students to grow and achieve their personal best.

The building will be constructed over top of the parking area on the east side of our current building. In addition to providing much-needed academic spaces for continued growth, this approach will eliminate disruption to the student experience during construction and will also provide us with some covered parking spaces.

The construction process, materials and energy use of the new facilities will all support Southpointe's commitment to be a leader in environmental sustainability and to teach students about climate change mitigation and environmental stewardship through the campus itself.
